An animated and impassioned Michael Ostrzyga conducts the Harvard Summer School Chorus and the Boston Moderr Orchestra Project in a performance — including a world premiere — of W. A. Mozart's "Requiem" Sunday afternoon in t Peterborough Town House. The performance was part of the continuing Monadnock Music summer concert series. Moz died while writing "Requiem," leaving it to posterity to interpret his drafts and surmise his intent. Ostrzyga, an internatior composer, composed his own ending to Mozart's piece, which he, as guest conductor, premiered Sunday before a near house. The performance was received with a lengthy standing ovation. Ostrzyga is music director at the University of Cologne in Germany.
